Free data, calls and text SIM cards

Are you eligible for a free SIM card from the Greater Manchester Databank? You must be:

- 18+ years old
- From a low income household
- With limited or no access to the internet

The Bolton Digital, Employment and Skills team can provide eligible residents with free data, calls and texts SIM card for up to twelve months.




